Knowing The Heart Of Maya's Civilization

Also included is a day-trip to Chichen Itza. It was the most important regional capital of the Mayan culture from 750 to 1200 B.C. Their structures are well conserved, as well as the Yucatan ancient Mayas tales. Their vestiges show the incredible Mayan civilization and architecture, enriched with other cultural currents of Mesoamerica. The temple of Kukulcán, also called "El Castillo", is a magnificent construction of 23 meters of height in pyramidal form. It has four faces, in which during the equinox a shade of a serpent can be seen descending by the stairs of the building. You will also visit the Ball Game (the greatest of Mesoamerica), the Observatory, the Temple of the Soldiers with its figure of the Chac-Mool and the sacred cenote.
